Rules for creating a practice diary

The mandatory reporting documents for a student's internship are a diary and a reporting form ("Report of the Assistant Dentist-Surgeon").

The internship diary and other documentation are filled out in Russian.

The internship diary should include protocols of the work performed by the student during the internship. The protocols are filled out for each day of the internship. The protocol should include information about the date and the work performed during the individual assignment.

When recording the work performed during the individual assignment (IA), the following algorithm should be followed:

1. For each day of practice, the protocol should describe 3-5 patients.
2. The first column at the beginning of each working day indicates the date, followed by the serial number of each patient received (a sequential numbering of patients received by the student during the entire practice period).
3. In the second column, the patient's passport data and the number of their outpatient record are specified, and the clinical diagnosis is formulated in detail, including the dental formula. It is important to avoid abbreviations, symbols, or conventions. If the patient visits again with the same condition, the diagnosis should be recorded as "Acute purulent periostitis of the upper jaw in the area of 567. Condition after periostomy" or "Alveolitis in the area of 37. Condition after curettage."
4. In the "Local status, justification of treatment" column, objective data should be entered to the extent necessary to justify the treatment being performed. In this case, the reasons that justify the treatment measures should be listed, such as the inability to restore the crown with a filling or other structures, unsatisfactory root canal filling in the presence of destructive foci in the periapical tissues, bifurcation destruction, etc.
5. The last column describes the performed medical actions, indicating the student's participation in them (performed independently under the doctor's supervision, assisted, or observed). When describing local anesthesia, it is necessary to specify the method of local anesthesia used. Special attention should be paid to the suitability of the anesthesia used for the nature and scope of the medical intervention. It is also necessary to specify the name, quantity, and concentration of the local anesthetic used.
6. After describing each patient, the student must sign the report.
7. The practice report must be signed by:
 - a) after each protocol (day of work), by the student's direct supervisor.
 - b) after the end of the practice, by the supervisor from the department and the supervisor from the specialized organization (practice base).
8. The reporting form ("Report of the Assistant Dentist-Surgeon") must include data on all the work performed.
